ADMISSION PROCESS AND PAYMENT THROUGH E-COUNSELLING AND ONLINE SYSTEM

After Publishing of Final Merit List, the Phase wise **E-COUNSELLING LIST** (as per the Intake Capacity) will be published as per the Admission Notice. **The Selected candidates will have to scan original copies of M.P. Admit Card, Marksheet of Last Examination, Caste Certificate, PWD Certificate, & EWS Certificate etc. and upload it to the portal (Max size : 100 kb and in jpg format) and pay the Admission Fees within the stipulated date(s) positively. All the Admission will be processed through E-Counseling and Admission Fees will have to pay through online process (using Credit/Debit Card/Net Banking). Candidates are advised to follow the Admission/E-Counseling notice in regular basis.**

They are also advised to check the Admission Payment Status. If discrepancies arise in this regard they will have to contact the college office within the admission period positively. No objection will be entertained after the last date of admission is over.

If a candidate does not fulfill the eligibility criteria and submit false representation in any data, the admission will be treated as cancelled at any stage. All the admission through Online will be treated as "Provisional". After verifying the Original documents, the admission will be treated as "Final". The date(s) of Documents Verification will be notified later on.

SELECTION PROCESS FOR ADMISSION

For the students of Vidyasagar University

- (a) As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal 80% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of V.U and 20% seats will be available for Open Competition.
- (b) Selection will be made strictly on the basis of Merit. Marks obtained in the honours subject will be the sole criteria. Honours candidates of the current session and the immediately preceding session will be considered equally. In the case of equal marks in honours subject, total marks/percentage of immediately preceding examination are to be taken into account for ranking.
- (c) Quota for SC/ST will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn/Estt dated 18.09.1997. Number of seats (SC - 22% , ST - 6%, OBC-A -10%, OBC-B - 7%) will be calculated and considered separately for 80% seats of V.U. students and 20% seats for Open Competition. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number. In case of non - availability of candidates of SC category, the seats reserved for SC may be converted to ST category and vice versa.
- (d) In case of non - availability of candidates of OBC -A category, the seats reserved for OBC - A may be converted to OBC -B category and vice versa.
- (e) 5% seats of each category will be reserved for persons with Disability (PWD) candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of PWD. In case of non-availability of PWD candidate, the seat reserved for PWD will be converted to that Category only.
- (f) Normally 80% seats will be reserved for the students of the Vidyasagar University and 20% seats for Open Competition. This 80% and 20% may be relaxed in case of non-availability of the applicants in either category.
